Reason for Need: This product has proven effective against subterranean termites; the other termite product is a contact termicide and ineffective against underground termites and lacks residual effects.
Options/Alternatives: Chitin-inhibiting bait stations may be used as alternative; however, bait stations are not listed on Allowable Pesticide List and similar exemption is required.
Plan to Preclude Future Use: Continue to monitor for termite activities at appropriate time of the year.
